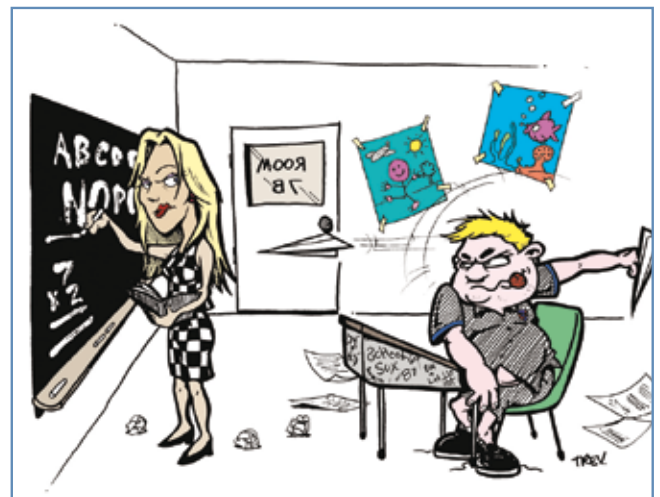

# A Course in Classroom Behaviour Management 1-2-3 Magic™ and Emotion Coaching in the Classroom (K-Yr7)

This is a simple classroom discipline programme for children aged 3 – 12 years. It has been introduced into many Western Australian classrooms with excellent outcomes.

Whether implemented in one classroom or across the whole school, the feedback and results obtained from educators are (according to them) very satisfying.

## The program is based on two underlying premises.

**First** – children can be taught ways in which they can respond more flexibly when they have to manage limits imposed on them.

**Second** – teachers will be more effective and enjoy their teaching more if they have a repertoire of strategies for dealing with non-compliant or disruptive students.
